Association to Horizon Europe

- Association is the closest form of international cooperation
- Horizon Europe is open for association of non-EU countries in the EU's proximity and Third countries with good capacity in science, technology and innovation located anywhere in the world – novelty in Horizon Europe
- Taking into account objective of driving economic growth in Europe through innovation.
- Intensified targeted actions
- Strengthened support to multilateral cooperation
- Openness balanced with the promotion of EU strategic autonomy



Moldova joins Horizon Europe, the EU research and innovation programme

- the Horizon Europe Association Agreement signed on 27 October, provisionally applies as of 3 November.

- On 26 November the Parliament of Moldova has completed the ratification procedure.
- The ratification shall take effect in these days after the promulgation of the Presidential Decree and publication in the national Official Journal of Moldova.



- The Republic of Moldova is now formally a Horizon Europe Associated Country;
- Moldovan entities have the status of entities from an Associated Country and Grant Agreements can be signed with them;
- Representatives of the Republic of Moldova should be invited as observers to all governance structures implementing the programme,
- Representatives of Moldova can now be invited and participate as observers in the JRC Board of Governors
- The national contact points provisionally appointed by the Moldovan side should now be fully included in all activities of the National Contact Points (NCPs) network.

- Strong political message as association confirms the privileged relations between the sides and reinforces strategic alliance;
- Prestige of participating in the deepest possible way in the world's largest R&I programme. It grants direct access to researchers, innovators, research institutes and world-leading research infrastructures of the 27 EU Member States and an expected 18-25 Associated Countries;
- Moldovan entities are treated the same as the ones from EU Member States;
- Moldova pays a financial contribution to the Programme;
- Moldova has influence (but no decision-making power) over the shaping of the Work Programmes;
- Associated Countries can participate in Article 185 and Article 187 initiatives and in the Board of Governors of the Joint Research Centre (JRC);

- Benefit from support services, such as the network of National Contact Points (NCPs).
- NCPs receive personalised support such as on calls, proposal drafting, how to look for project partners, and provides information on Horizon Europe in applicants' own languages (established and trained by the services of the European Commission).
- Promotion of common principles for the conduct of international research and innovation activities in order to create incentives and a level playing field for researchers and innovators.
- Cost sharing of large R&I projects or investment-intensive infrastructures.
