
GÉANT vision

To ensure equal network access and services for all scientists across Europe to the research infrastructures and the e-infrastructure resources available to them.









Drivers of cloud adoption in R&E sector

- Pandemic-driven transformation: COVID-19 accelerated remote learning and digital collaboration
- Simplified procurement: OCRE framework streamlined access to cloud services
- Cost efficiency: "Pay-as-you-go" models and scalable resources
- Innovation & collaboration: cloud tools enhanced research and educational collaboration
- Advanced technologies: support for AI, ML, and big data analytics








Previous frameworks: countries








28 countries as at 31/12/2024

OCRE 2024: key aspects







- **GÉANT as Central Purchasing Body**: 40 (N)RENs, 39 countries
- 1 lot per country; sub-lots per platform
- Max 3 suppliers per sub-lot
- Framework duration: 5 years (3 Feb 2025 2 Feb 2030)
- NRENs role: default or underwriter
- No obligation to procure

Contracts:

- 416 Frameworks under Dutch law
- Call-off Contracts (CoC) under local law
- Managed by the GÉANT Contract Management Group



OCRE 2024: scoring the monster tender...

OCRE E



- 496 bids
- Scored by 13 people from 8 countries
- Each working 3 days a week during 6 months
- Scoring in teams in consensus
- Automation was key, thousands of datapoints, auto generation award letters and the contracts
 - **Resulting in** 416 Framework Agreements signed and no objections




OCRE 2024: benefits





- Expanded services: IaaS, PaaS, SaaS options
- Cloud service offerings: hyperscale platforms and European platforms (including Original Infrastructure Providers)
- Reduced costs: not running individual tenders, discounts
- Better commercial terms: individual tenders would not result in favourable conditions or discounts
- Enhanced compliance: stronger alignment with EU regulations





OCRE 2024: eligible institutions

Participating entities to benefit from OCRE 2024 are divided into three groups:

Group A: The NREN and all its members with R&E focus

Group B: All institutions with a R&E focus that are, for whatever reason, not a member of the NREN

Group C: All institutions that are affiliated with the NREN but do not have a R&E focus (may include central government bodies, must be non-profit organisations)

Law No. 131 of July 3, 2015 on public procurement Article 5. Exceptions: "contracts for research and development services ..."








OCRE 2024: RENAM – default role NREN


